Checking In

Security

The Security Alarm will remain off for the duration of your stay.

- Please refrain from touching the white security control panels by the front door and under the stairs.
- The security cameras in the property have no listening capability and will have the lenses covered for your stay.
- The external cameras will be turned off, with the exception of the camera covering the driveway.
- It is not possible to charge electric vehicles.
- For more information, please see the printed manual.



PLEASE double check that all doors and windows are locked before going out. The patio doors must be closed with the handles pointing downwards.

10 GOLDEN RULES

- **Smoking**, Vaping and the use of drugs are forbidden.
- **Animals** are not allowed in the property or garden.
- **Plastic cups** are provided for pool area use. Broken glass can cause serious injury and damage to the pool liner.
- **Pool Security Cover** may be removed, you are then responsible for ensuring pool safety. Please watch your children at all times.
- **Garden gate** must be kept locked at all times.
- **Gas hob** must be supervised while in use.
- **Charcoal BBQ** must not be used during an open fire ban in periods of "secheresse", and must be supervised at all times while in use.
- **Wifi** is provided on the property for use according to French law.
- **Washing and drying machines** are provided for your use at your own risk.
- **Air Conditioner**: all doors and windows must be kept shut during use, without fail, and be set at a minimum of 26 degrees when you are out.

POOL SAFETY

You may remove the protective pool cover.

You are then responsible for ensuring pool safety.

Please be extremely vigilant and watch your children at all times.

The depth at the **shallow end is 1.4m.**

The depth at the **deep end is 1.8m.**

No diving is permitted.

POOL COVER REMOVAL

Please replace the cover before you leave.

POOL MAINTENANCE

Our pool maintenance technician will visit up to two times per week. He has access to the garage and garden only. You do not need to be present during his visits.

If you experience any issues, please let us know.

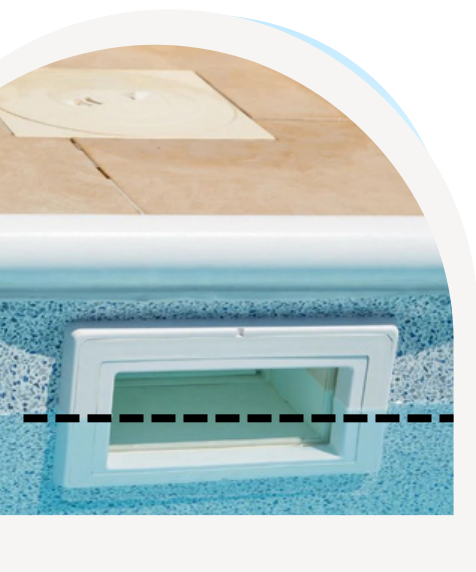

WATER LEVEL

If the water level drops **below the mid-line level of the skimmer**, please fill the pool using the hose.

In case of drought (sécheresse), this can be done after 8pm.

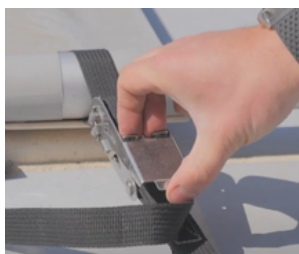

IN CASE OF DROUGHT

In the event the government or commune announces a state of drought, there may be water use restrictions and/or a ban on re-filling pools.

In this event, please keep the pool cover on at all times when not in use to avoid evaporation of the water.

Once the water level has dropped below a certain level, the pump cannot function and the pool can no longer be used.

These are, unfortunately, circumstances beyond our control which we sincerely regret.

Important Information

GARDEN

The garden gate must be kept locked at all times, unless you are using it in that moment – this is a legal requirement to avoid problems with children falling in the pool.

Garden plants
There are some **cacti growing in the garden which are spiky**. Please watch your children and avoid touching them.



The shade sail

Please see printed instructions or [click here](#) for how to put it up and take it down. Please take it down if you experience storm winds and before you leave.

Automatic watering

Comes on during the night. Be sure to remove everything from the lawn or it will get wet.

BBQ

Never leave the BBQ unattended whilst in use. Please ensure the charcoal is fully extinguished after use. Please do not move the BBQ or use it on the patio. It may not be used during a ban on open fires in the Clape area. Please check the commune website.





Important Information **GARDEN**

Garage

Inflatable pool loungers and pump will be found in the garage.

Please store inflatables in the garage overnight.

Please note we do not provide a parasol due to potential windy conditions.

Mosquitos share the garden, consider the use of a suitable repellent.

If you have opened the door, please ensure it is locked before going out.

Feel free to use the garage to store your outdoor belongings (eg bikes, etc).

Unsupervised children are not permitted in the garage as pool chemicals and other such items are stored there.

Sunloungers

4 sun loungers are at your disposal.



Important information

Air Conditioning

If the air con is on, it's vital that you keep all external doors and windows shut all the time without fail otherwise the units will drip, damaging the walls and energy is wasted trying to air condition the village, which isn't good for the environment.

When you leave the house, simply raise the temperature to at least 26 degrees C.

You can lower it to a more comfortable level when you return.

There is an air conditioning unit in the dining room, and another at the top of the stairs. To keep the bedrooms and bathrooms cool, leave the interior doors open (except the laundry door) so the cold air can circulate throughout the whole villa.



Locking the patio door

Important information

For security, the patio doors only open from the inside. There's a magnetic strip on the first patio door. This will usually hold the door shut so you can come and go from the garden whilst easily keeping the door shut at all times whilst you are outside. If it's very windy, the strips won't hold and the door will keep blowing open, you'll need to use the front door and walk round, please. We kindly request you take care the front door doesn't slam shut in the wind.

When going out, make sure that the patio door is shut with the handle pushed to the down position, and not just held on the magnetic strips.



Lock the doors when you go out. The handles should be pointing downwards





TV & WiFi

The television is provided for use according to French law and is equipped with an SFR TV package where you can find various TV channels. You can also use the SFR system to log in to your own Netflix, Prime, Disney or other streaming service accounts.

SFR is accessible on HDMI 1. Scroll down to find the streaming channels to log in to.

Hot Water

The 200 litre tank is in the garage.

Please not note that it can take up to two minutes for the hot water to reach the house.

- Bathroom radiators automatically turn on 1 hr a day
- The bathroom cabinets are sadly NOT waterproof, please be careful

Cleaning

- The vacuum cleaner Henry and a mop and bucket, brooms, etc are provided for your use.
- Cleaning supplies are available under the sink.
- Please leave any items clean as you found them.
- Please replace any kitchen supplies you use.

03

Furniture

Please don't sit on any indoor furniture wearing wet swimsuits or suntan lotion

The **sofa** can be re-made daily by plumping and re-adjusting the seat cushions so they are as far back as possible.

Bins

Please dispose of your household waste in the container at the end of the street.

Please place recycling in the appropriate bins. The location of the bins can be found on the map on the wall in the laundry.

KITCHEN WORKTOP

Please use the trivets and chopping boards provided.

Don't place hot items or use knives to cut anything directly on the worktop.

LAUNDRY

Laundry - The washing machine is available for your use in the laundry. **Please do not use the dryer function on the brown machine.** For washing, program is No. 5 at 30 or 40 degrees is usually adequate. In the unlikely event you need a tumble dryer, please use the white one. You'll also find a clothes dryer, pegs, iron and mini ironing board in the Laundry. **Please keep the internal laundry door shut at all times.**



We accept no responsibility for any washing or drying mishaps. Be sure to choose a program and temperature that suits the type of item you are washing. Do not mix dark and light colours. Do not leave the villa with the washing machine or tumble dryer going. If you prefer to use a commercial washing station, the nearest one is available at the Intermarché supermarket at Salles d'Aude and others can be found in the area.

BEACH UMBRELLA

(and beach bag) is in the laundry. It comes with a yellow screw device to fix in to the sand.

Please be sure not to lose the black rubber joining device, or it will not fit together.
